Weather : annual average temperature is 13.5℃

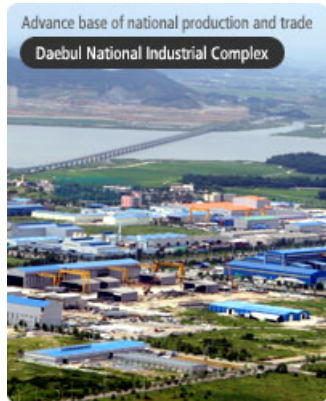
Regional characteristics
